Applications are now being accepted from Island and Skagit County community members to participate in the Climate Steward Volunteer Training Program.

WHAT DO THE CLIMATE STEWARD VOLUNTEERS DO?

Climate Stewards receive 20 hours of FREE professional training:

- Become familiar with the science of climate change, impacts of global warming and actions that reduce global warming pollution.
- Hear from LOCAL EXPERTS on a variety of topics and issues.
- Meet new friends and join a community of concerned citizens – be a part of the solution.

In exchange, participants return at least 20 hours of volunteer service over the next eight months:

- Develop and implement outreach projects in your community with ongoing training and support.
- Participate in meaningful community projects that promote energy conservation and other strategies to reduce global warming emissions.
- Volunteer projects are geared toward the interests of the participant.
